Thursdays will be celebrated in St. Cadoc's as a Day of Prayer for Priests. Parishioners are asked to pray this week for: Fr. John Keenan, LL.B., Ph.L., S.T.B., who was born in Glasgow in 1964 and who had his secondary education at the Salesian College in Cheshire. After graduating in Law at the University of Glasgow, he prepared for the priesthood at the Pontifical Scots College and the Pontifical Gregorian University in Rome. He was ordained priest in the church of St. Gregory, Wyndford on 9<sup>th</sup> July 1995 by His Eminence Thomas Joseph Cardinal Winning, Archbishop of Glasgow. Having served in various parishes in the Archdiocese, Fr. Keenan is now chaplain and Parish Priest at the University of Glasgow. His brother Gerard and his family are resident in St. Cadoc's Parish.

## **Altar**

You may have noticed some changes on the Altar. There is now a standing Crucifix and on Sundays there will be four candles instead of two. This is in conformity with The General Instruction of the Roman Missal Chapter IV article 117 which states that there should be at least two lighted candles on the altar and even four or six on a Sunday. Indeed when the diocesan bishop celebrates, there should be seven candlesticks with lighted candles. The same article states that there should be on the altar a cross adorned with a figure of Christ crucified. In fact, there has always been a crucifix on the altar but it was a small one that laid flat. The new standing crucifix, which can be seen by the people as well as by the priest, is an old crucifix which has recently been refurbished.
